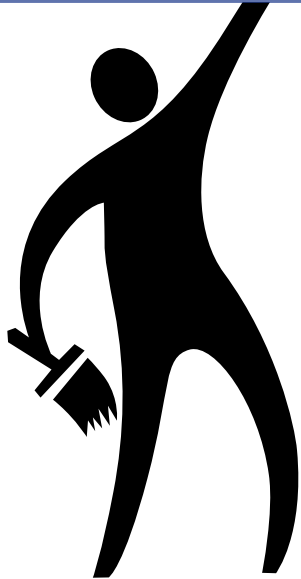

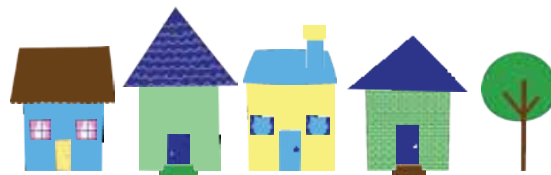


Rebuild the Block: June 23, 2018

Program Sponsorships: Year-Round

Rebuilding Together Tulsa offers home repairs through four programs. Sponsorships supporting each of our programs are available from **\$1,000- \$100,000**.

- **Roofs:** Roof repair and replacement.
- **Safe at Home:** Includes home modification repairs such as wheelchair ramps, grab bars, ADA compliant faucets, handheld showers, shower seats, raised toilets, fire safety and other repairs that ensure the safety of the homeowner.
- **Energy Efficiency:** Energy efficiency repairs help provide a weatherproof home and decrease energy bills for the low-income families we serve. These repairs can include attic insulation, replacing broken windows, sealing cracks around doors and windows, installing compact fluorescent (CFL) light bulbs, installing water conserving fixtures and any other repairs that are considered energy efficient on a case-by-case basis for the individual homeowner.
- **R.O.O.T. (Repairs Offered Other Times):** The R.O.O.T. program includes all other repairs not offered as part of the other three programs and can include electrical, plumbing, painting and any other repairs that are considered necessary to make the home safe, secure and weatherproof or improve the neighborhood.



Annual Fund

Donations to the annual fund are utilized year-round to help support our work of providing safe and healthy homes for low-income Tulsa neighbors. Donors receive recognition as listed on the leadership recognition chart.

Construction Materials:

Donate building materials that can be utilized during repair projects. Some common needs include roof shingles, decking, felt, caulk, tools, lumber, sheetrock, weatherstripping, CFL light bulbs, CO2/smoke detectors, portable wheelchair ramps, etc.

Professional Service:

We need help from licensed electricians, roofers and plumbers. We also need carpenters and other skilled trades people such as wheelchair ramp installers, etc.

On-Site Repair Supplies:

We need rakes, step ladders, latex gloves, heavy-duty work gloves, window cleaner, paper towels and trash bags.

Office/Administrative Needs:

You can donate a copier, white printer paper, plain manila file folders, letter-size hanging folders, legal size hanging folders, mailing labels, printer ink cartridges, data entry personnel time, client intake personnel time, and training help.
